December 31, New Year's Eve Regatta and Fireworks

All aboard for the New Year's Eve Regatta, one of the top nautical events of the year, with sailboats of all sizes including mega-yachts responding to the invitation issued by the St Barth Yacht Club and taking part in his fun and festive parade around the island. The day concludes with the traditional fireworks display high above the harbor of Gustavia to ring in the New Year.

Music and film festivals

January 9 -25, A Star-Studded Festival of Classical Music

The St Barth Music Festival is a highly anticipated cultural event. For two weeks, the island is home to a galaxy of international stars of music, dance, and opera that perform regularly in New York, Paris, Milan, and other leading cities. Concerts of classical music, recitals, dance and opera performances take place around the island, in open-air settings as well as the churches in Lorient and Gustavia.

From December to March: Humpback Whale Watching!

From December to March, you can observe whales around the island of St Barthélemy as well as the "Tursiops truncatus" bottlenose dolphin. These fabulous animals are part of the 33 species of marine mammals that frequent the waters around the island and are under the surveillance of the Agoa marine mammal sanctuary and the Réserve Naturelle Marine de St Barthélemy.
